Fort Worth Tour, Bureau of Engraving & Printing, and Naval Air Station Friday, Oct 26 – 0900-1800



Fort Worth will capture your heart with its charming blend of the Wild West and modern cultures. We will go on a historical tour from what was once a wild frontier inhabited by buffalo and Indians to the present city with its magnificent skyscrapers. The Fort Worth Stockyards is the history book of the livestock industry in Texas. For drovers heading longhorn cattle up the Chisholm Trail, Fort Worth was the last major stop for rest and supplies. Also enjoy a visit to the Fort Worth Bureau of Engraving & Printing aka the Mint. See where billions of dollars are printed, as you stand on an enclosed

walkway, suspended above the production floor. Over half of the nation's currency order is produced in Fort Worth – who knew?! Afterwards we will head to the famous *Stockyards* to watch a longhorn cattle-drive right down Main Street! Lunch will be on your own in Sundance Square.

Finally head over to the <u>Naval Air Station</u>. As a Joint Reserve Base, it serves as home to a variety of Navy, Marine Corps, Air Force, Army and Texas Air National Guard units. Established on October 1, 1994 as the first Joint Reserve Base in the country, their mission is to provide unsurpassed support and quality training for the Reserve and Guard "war fighters" in all branches of the Armed Services. Subject to security, availability and the needs of the service, we hope to get an "up close and personal" tour of the flight line, with cargo planes and F-16 and F-35 fighter jets, plus other facilities of a modern military air station. We suggest you wear comfortable shoes and bring drinking water and a hat.



Dallas City Tour, including the George W. Bush Presidential Library & Museum Saturday, Oct 27 – 0900-1700



Board your coach for a City Tour of the Big D! Home to the Dallas Mavericks, Dallas Stars and more! You will visit the West End historical district which is the site of the former Texas School Depository building, then take a brief walking tour of John F. Kennedy's memorial and the old red courthouse. Stop at a few points of interest in downtown Dallas and then head to the Cultural Arts District. There you will see the famous AT&T performing arts center, Dallas Museum of Art, and the locals'

favorite – Klyde Warren Park. Lunch will be on your own downtown. Meet back at the bus to depart to the Bush Presidential Library and Museum.

The <u>George W. Bush Library</u>'s state of the art exhibits include a stunning presentation on terrorism and the World Trade Center bombing, including artifacts and a day-by-day timeline post- 911, as experienced through the eyes of the President. An interactive "Decision Theater" thrusts you into the decision making process that a President experiences during a crisis. Sit at a desk, get the facts and struggle with the same questions as "W". Then make the call!



JFK Museum, 6th Floor Book Depository, and Historic Grapevine Sunday, Oct 28 – 0930-1500

The <u>Sixth Floor Museum at Dealey Plaza</u> chronicles the assassination and legacy of President John F. Kennedy, and interprets the Dealey Plaza National Historic Landmark District and the John F. Kennedy Memorial Plaza. The exhibits explore the events surrounding JFK within the context of 1960s history and culture. We all remember where we were when JFK was killed. Experience the place where it happened, then board your bus to head for lunch on your own in Grapevine.





Step back in time to quaint <u>Historic Downtown Grapevine</u>. On six blocks of Main Street you will find 10 wine tasting rooms (it *is* called Grapevine, after all), a dozen great cafés and unique, independent stores for browsing Texas antiques and curios, historic museums (all free) and a vintage train depot. After lunch on your own and time for a little browsing on Main Street, we'll head back to the Hotel.
